1

Form a Relationship

We should seek out new Christians that we can come alongside of and help guide them through the Christian walk. This can be anyone from newcomers at church to people we helped lead to Christ.

Be a Godly Role Model

Help Them Grow Spiritually

Involve Them In a Discipleship Group

Small groups or discipleship groups are essential for spiritual growth of new believers. Christian relationships are necessary for new Christians and their spiritual walk.

Serve God

We have the privilege of serving God. This is our honor and joy which should be passed on to new believers as well. It is even more helpful to serve alongside our disciples.

Commission Them to Make Disciples

Ultimately, our goal is to get our disciples to a point where they are equipped to make disciples of their own. We can still meet and grow together, however they are now mentoring their own disciples.
