



JESUS' Return



Jesus will return to the earth to carry off or "rapture" His Church.





THE TRIBULATION: JUDGMENT

During the tribulation, God will send judgment onto the earth.

Humanity's corruption and evilness will be unparalleled during these days and they will receive the wrath of God as punishment and to lead them to repentance. Even with all the signs and warnings, mankind will continue to worship the Antichrist and curse God. In the book of Revelation, God's wrath is illustrated by:

7 seals, 7 trumpets, and 7 bowls


7 seals



THE ANTICHRIST

The Antichrist will rise to power before the tribulation period and reign during the tribulation. He will be empowered by Satan and cause mass persecution of Christians and Jews.

World Government	Revelation 13:7-8 sheds light on how extensive the Antichrist's empire will be by using phrases such as "authority over every tribe, people, language and nation" and "all inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast". It is likely that the Antichrist will be the leader of a one world government.
7 Year Treaty with Israel	The tribulation period will begin with the signing of a 7 year peace treaty between the Antichrist and Israel (Daniel 9:27). The Antichrist will come proclaiming peace and will be adored and followed by billions, however he will deceive them all by turning against Israel halfway through the 7 year treaty.
Empowered by Satan	"The dragon (Satan) gave the beast (the Antichrist) his power and his throne and great authority." <i>Revelation 13:2</i>
Abomination of Desolation	The Antichrist will turn God's Temple into a place where he will receive worship. He will construct an image in the Temple that people will be required to worship. This event will occur halfway between the tribulation period and will usher in the Great Tribulation.
False Prophet	The False Prophet is the second beast described in Revelation 13. He too will receive power from Satan which will allow him to perform miraculous signs. He will worship the Antichrist and kill anyone who refuses to worship him as well.
Mark of the Beast	The False Prophet will require everyone to receive a mark in order to buy and sell. All people who receive the mark will experience the wrath of God. Revelation 14:9-11 indicates that everyone who receives the mark will be unable to receive forgiveness from God and will be punished by eternity in hell.
Demise	"But the beast was captured, and with it the false prophet who had performed the signs on its behalf. With these signs he had deluded those who had received the mark of the beast and worshiped its image. The two of them were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur." <i>Revelation 19:20</i>

THE MILLENNIUM KINGDOM

Jesus' Reign



"...he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land." *Jeremiah 23:5*



Christians

Christians will reign with Christ in the Millennium Kingdom with bodies that do not decay or die (Revelation 20:4-6).

The Rest of Humanity

There will be unbelievers in the Millennium Kingdom. They will be able to reproduce, marry, and die. They can also receive salvation during this time.

Amillennialism

This view holds that the Millennium Kingdom is not a literal 1000 year period. Proponents of this view believe that the Church Age is the Kingdom described in Revelation 20. This view fails to explain the chronological events in Revelation which places the Millennium after the tribulation in addition to the clear imagery of Jesus reigning on earth in bodily form during this period (Jeremiah 23:5-8).

Postmillennialism

This view states that the 1000 year Millennium is not a literal 1000 year period but rather a long period of time. Proponents of this view believe that Jesus will return after a period of prosperity experienced by the Church. They also believe that people will become more and more righteous over time until Christianity is practiced by nearly all. This view goes against Biblical end times prophecy.

Premillennialism

This view is the most common among Christians. Proponents of this view believe in a literal 1000 year period that occurs immediately after Jesus returns to put an end to the tribulation. This is the most literal interpretation of the passages regarding the Millennium Kingdom.

THE FINAL JUDGMENT





Satan is Loosed

"When the thousand years are over, Satan will be released from his prison." *Revelation 20:7*



Satan Leads a Rebellion

"and will go out to deceive the nations in the four corners of the earth—Gog and Magog—and to gather them for battle. In number they are like the sand on the seashore." *Revelation 20:8*



Satan is Defeated for Good

"And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever." *Revelation 20:10*



The Great White Throne Judgment

"Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence, and there was no place for them. And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books. The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead that were in them, and each person was judged according to what they had done. Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. The lake of fire is the second death. Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire." *Revelation 20:11-15*

THE RESTORATION OF CREATION

"Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

Revelation 21:1-4



God's original creation combined the Heavenly dimension and the Earthly dimension. These 2 dimesions were separated (and still are) as a result of sin. When God restores creation, He will reunite the 2 separate dimensions of Heaven and Earth. Eden will be restored and He will dwell among us again.

"In Genesis, God plants the Garden on Earth; in Revelation, he brings down the New Jerusalem, with a garden at its center, to the New Earth. In Eden, there's no sin, death, or Curse; on the New Earth, there's no *more* sin, death, or Curse. In Genesis, the Redeemer is promised; in Revelation, the Redeemer returns. Genesis tells the story of Paradise lost; Revelation tells the story of Paradise regained. In Genesis, humanity's stewardship is squandered; in Revelation, humanity's stewardship is triumphant, empowered by the human and divine King Jesus."

After Sin




Eternity
