


JESUS: THE FULFILLMENT OF THE LAW



Matthew 5:17

"Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them."



Animal Sacrifice

- ✔ Did not remove sin, temporarily covered sin (Heb. 10:4)
- ✔ The sacrifices would be offered daily (Num. 28:3)
- ✔ Served as a substitute for the Israelites' sins
- ✔ The substitute must be without blemish (Lev. 22:19)
- ✔ Pointed to Jesus' final sacrifice

Jesus' Final Sacrifice

- ✔ Removed sin through his blood (Eph. 1:7)
- ✔ Jesus' sacrifice was final (Heb. 10:10)
- ✔ Served as a substitute for humanity's sins (1 John 2:2)
- ✔ Was the ultimate unblemished sacrifice (Heb. 9:12)
- ✔ Opened the path to salvation for all humanity (Jn. 3:16)

THE HIGH PRIEST



- ✔ Entered the Most Holy Place by the blood of another (Heb. 9:12)
- ✔ Offered a sacrifice for his own sin before offering one for the rest of Israel (Lev. 16:6)
- ✔ Had to present a sacrifice every year (Lev. 16:34)

THE GREAT HIGH PRIEST

- ✔ Entered into the Most Holy Place by His own blood (Heb. 9:12)
- ✔ Did not need to make a sacrifice for Himself because He was already perfect (Heb. 7:11,28)
- ✔ Sacrifice was final and permanent (Heb. 9:25-26)



THE TEMPLE



- ✔ God's presence dwelled in the temple
- ✔ The temple was a physical building in Jerusalem where the people would worship God and make sacrifices



- ✔ The Holy Spirit dwells inside believers
- ✔ This allows direct access to God and does not require us to go to a specific place to worship God


THE NEW COVENANT

Jeremiah 31:31-34

"The days are coming, when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel. It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors. I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."



"This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."



"This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me."
